YOU:

- Advise you of the details for the next intake for our Volunteer Team
- Process paperwork

training & professional development

Before you can begin as a volunteer at the Art Gallery, you are required to attend our Training Program.

Attendance at all sessions is compulsory. But fear not, we make the experience interesting and enjoyable.

The objectives of the Program are to:

- Formally introduce you to your role as an Art Gallery Custodian
- Enable you to familiarize yourself with the Art Gallery Precinct
- Provide you with an insight into the vision and aims for the Art Gallery
- Give you an opportunity to meet other staff members and hear about their roles and responsibilities.

As part of your professional development we also offer more specialized on-the-job training, relevant to the work you undertake at the Art Gallery.

ongoing commitment
